



Photographing vendor booths is prohibited without vendor consent. No flash photography allowed.



## List of Basic Supplies

The following basic sewing supplies are expected for each class. Additional supplies may be necessary and will be indicated in the class description. Pressing stations are available in classrooms.

1. Needles (sewing machine and hand)
2. Neutral thread (machine and hand)
3. Thread to match fabric
4. Thimble
5. Pins (appliqué, standard and safety)
6. Scissors (fabric, 4" embroidery and paper)
7. Sharp pencils and eraser
8. Fabric marking pens or pencils
9. Small trash bag
10. Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat (minimum 18" x 24")
11. Seam ripper


